Mission of a Toastmasters Club

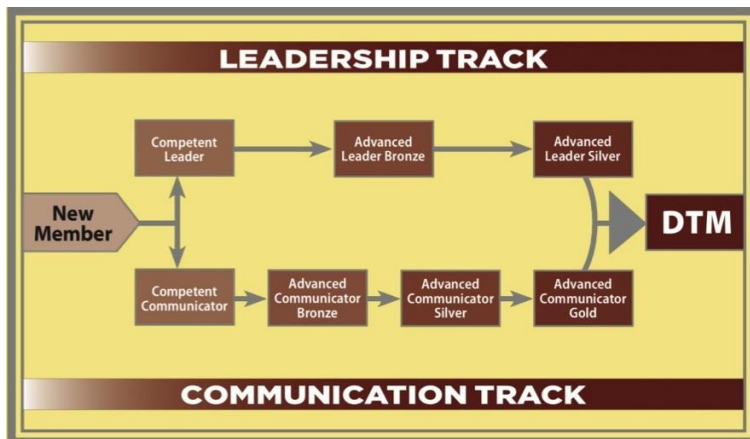

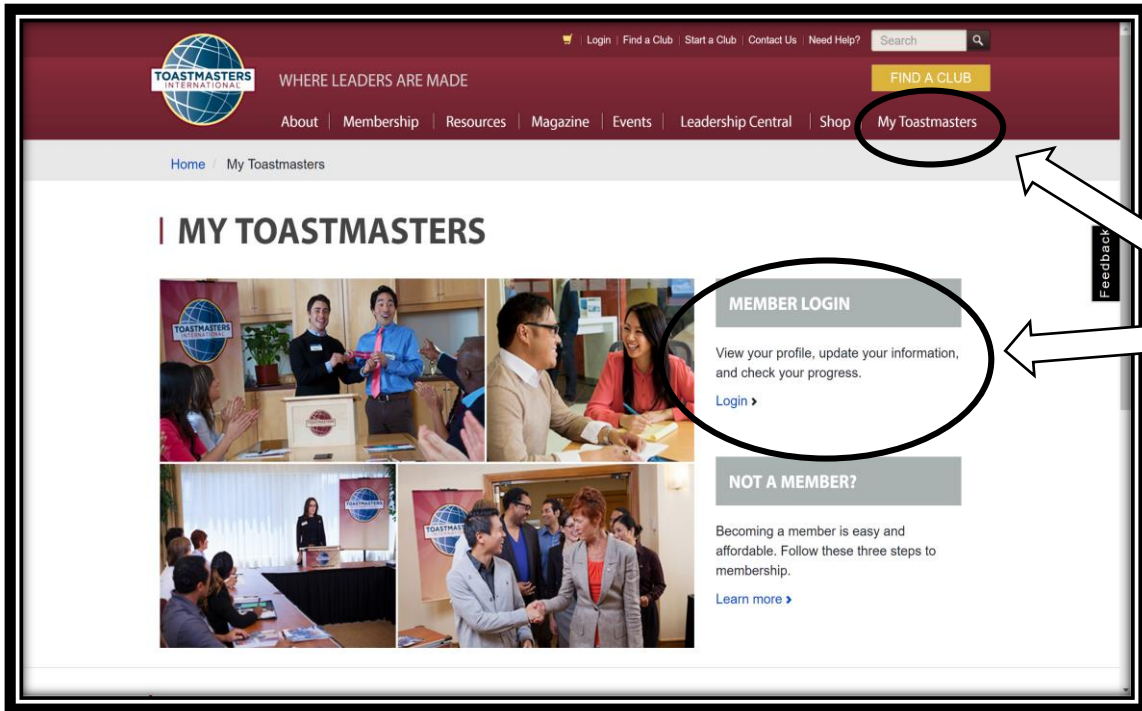
